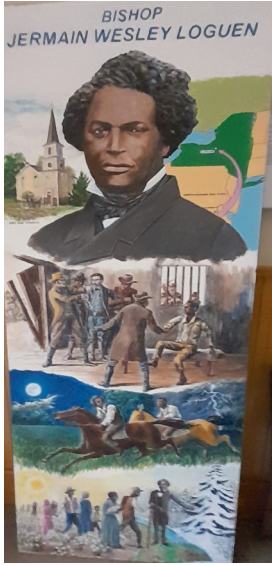


WHAT's Happening in Macedon Center hosted by Macedon Historical Society
